## **Changing Mac Security Settings to Allow the App**

MacOS may block apps from unidentified developers. Here's how to allow them:

- 1. Try to Open the App:
  - Save the app in a convenient location like your desktop or the Applications file.
  - Find the app and double-click it.
  - If you see a warning like "App can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer," click the **question mark** in the top right-hand corner of the warning. Then click "**Done**".
