

Changing Mac Security Settings to Allow the App


MacOS may block apps from unidentified developers. Here's how to allow them:

1. Try to Open the App:

- Save the app in a convenient location like your desktop or the Applications file.
- Find the app and double-click it.
- If you see a warning like "App can't be opened because it is from an unidentified developer," click the **question mark** in the top right-hand corner of the warning. Then click **"Done"**.



- In the Mac User Guide window that opened, click "Open Privacy and Security settings for me"



2. In Privacy & Security Settings:

- Scroll down to the **Security** section.
- You'll see a message saying the app was blocked. Click **"Open Anyway."**
- **Note:** The **"Open Anyway"** option only appears after clicking **"Done"** in step 1.
